- 5) Taking care of the orphaned infants and children, establishing home and providing food and medical assistance to them.
- 6) Organising Educational Institutions and Vocational Training Centers for the poor orphans and the Handicapped children and assisting them in getting suitable employment to earn their living.
- 7) Creating employment opportunities and providing employment to the poor and handicapped people by establishing cottage and small scale Industries.
- 8) Providing relief and assistance to people in case of emergency.

12) To establish and run schools, colleges of all kind and provide Hostel facilities in such schools and colleges.

13) To establish, develop, maintain and grant aid in cash or kind to the hospitals with all modern facilities, medical schools, medical colleges, nursing institutions, dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centers and/or such other similar charitable institutions in India for the benefit and use of the general public.

14) To establish, run, support and grant aid or other financial assistance to schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, Universities, Laboratories, Research and other Institutions of the like nature in India, for use of the students and the staff and also for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge among the public in general.

21) To construct and repair and manage mazarahs, cemeteries and burial grounds.

22) To grant aid or render assistance to other public charitable trusts or institutions.

23) To adopt village/villages for creating and providing basic necessities and to promote literacy amongst the villagers by establishing schools and other educational institutions including adult education.

**TRUSTEES:**

1) The AUTHOR OF THE TRUST and the Co-Trustee shall be permanent trustees for life or as long as they wish to continue as trustees.

2) The permanent trustees aforesaid shall be empowered to appoint, nominate or co-opt additional trustees

not exceeding ten in number. The permanent trustees shall also fix the terms of appointment and qualifications of additional trustees.

3) The non-appointment of additional trustees against the vacancy caused by resignation, retirement, death, and sickness or otherwise will not invalidate the trust or any action done on behalf of the trust.


4) Permanent trustees who hold the office for life shall be removed only for the reason of breach of trust.

5) In case of death of a permanent trustee, the surviving permanent trustees may appoint any other person as the permanent trustee, who will hold the office for life. The same procedure required to be followed in all occasions of vacancies caused due to the death, retirement or the insolvency of the permanent trustees.

6) In case of vacancy arising on account of death, retirement or the insolvency of an additional trustee, the permanent trustees will have the right to fill the vacancies by co-opting additional trustees for such term and on such terms and conditions, which they think proper.

**PROVIDED**, that the term of the additional trustees shall not exceed a maximum period of five years. But, the permanent trustees will have a right to appoint an additional trustee for further such period not exceeding five years, if they think necessary.

7) The Trustees shall be accountable only for such moneys, stocks, shares and funds as shall actually come to their hands and trustees shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts or omissions or commissions of the other trustees nor of any banker or other person with whom the trust properties or any security may have been deposited or kept.



8) The trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the trust or the duties relating thereto.

**BOARD TRUSTEES:**

All the power of administration, control and authority in respect of trust funds and properties shall vest in the board of trustees for the benefit of and achievement object and purposes of the trust

**POWERS OF THE BOARD TRUSTEES:**

1) The trustees shall be entitled to receive upon such terms and conditions as they may deem fit, donations, subscriptions, contributions and gifts in cash or in kind, to hold and administer such receipt and to collect funds public or private for carrying out the objects of the trust.

2) The Trustees shall be entitled to enter into contracts or agreements necessary for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the trust.

3) For the purpose of carrying the objects of the trust, the trustees shall be entitled to employ, retain or from time to time employ professionals, skilled personnel, technical advisors, consultants, staff and engage such other employees and servants and pay for their services, such fee, honorariums, salaries or remunerations as the trustees may deem fit, and suspend, remove, dismiss or terminate the employment of any such persons so employed.

4) The Trustees for the purpose or carrying out the objects of the Trust shall be entitled to purchase or acquire properties either movable or immovable.

5) The Trustees shall utilize and invest the Trust fund and its income from the property movable or immovable or from the work of the trust as such whenever derived, for the objects of the trust as set forth in the trust deed.

**PROVIDED,** no portion there of shall be transferred directly or indirectly or otherwise to distribute among the trustees by way of profits, dividends or bonus. This shall not prevent the trustees of remunerations for special jobs and works and to the benefits for which these projects are organized.

6) Proper accounts showing all receipt and disbursements made on account of the trust hereby constituted shall be kept by the trustees and the same shall be duly audited with all necessary vouchers at least once in every year by such chartered Accountants as the trustees may appoint.

7) The trustee shall have full power to compromise or compound all actions, suits and proceedings and all differences and demands and to refer any disputes or differences to Arbitration, Conciliation, and Mediation and to

10) To accept any donation, contribution, grants or subscription in cash or in kind, for any person/s, body of persons or trust, with or without conditions.



11) To apply the whole or any part of the income of the trust fund or accumulations thereto, to any one or more of the objects of the trust, as the trustees may in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.

12) To convert and deal with the trust property and/or any investment for the time being.

13) To invest the trust fund either in the purpose of mortgage of immovable property or in shares, stocks or

The Executive Trustees will have the power and has to carry out the functions provided in the regulation framed by trustees for day-to-day management and administration of the trust on constitution of the Board i.e., after completion of the co-option of additional trustees. The Executive Trustees so appointed shall at all times during that period devote his time and attention to and faithfully employ himself therefore and carry out all the necessary steps for the greatest advantage and efficient management of the trust. The Executive Trustee shall, for the service rendered be entitled to draw remuneration/honorarium and other perquisites as the trustees may from time to time determine. In case of the death, retirement or discharge of the Executive Trustee, the Board of trustees are empowered to appoint any one of the permanent trustees as the Executive Trustee, in accordance with the regulations framed by them for the smooth functioning of the trust.

**MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:**


1) The Board of Trustees under the chairmanship of the Executive Trustee shall meet at least once in every three months to review the affairs of the Trust and pass such resolutions as may be necessary for its working, in conformity with the general regulations. The quorum for the meeting should be a minimum of two trustees.

2) Every resolution or decision of the Board of Trustees, unless unanimous, shall be taken by a majority of the trustees present and voting. In case of equality of votes, the Chairman of the meeting shall have the casting vote. The Trustees may pass any resolution by circulation and it should be unanimous.

3) An emergency meeting of the Board of Trust may be called for by any of the trustee by notice in writing to the Executive Trustee, giving the agenda and points to be discussed at the emergency meeting. The expenses concerning and holding the emergency meeting shall be borne by the trustee calling for such meeting. The Executive Trustee in receiving the notice of such emergency meeting shall cause the notice on the remaining trustees informing

them of the subject matter of discussion, place and time of the meeting. Such notice of the meeting caused by the executive trustee shall be caused on the trustees at least twenty four hours prior to the meeting.

4) The trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any moneys or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoing ought to be paid or borne from the trust funds from any Chartered Accountant or Advocate and every such determination shall be binding and the opinion given by the Chartered Accountant or Advocate is conclusive.

**PROVIDED,** that nothing contained hereinabove shall be deemed to authorise the trustees to spend the income or corpus of the trust for any purpose not authorised by these presents.

**EXPLANATION** that the Chairmanship of the meeting will precede alternatively by executive trustees.
